

## **Tableau Privacy and GDPR FAQ**

## What type of information does Tableau collect?

The type of information we collect will depend on your interactions with Tableau. It may include:

- Contact information
- Payment information
- Registration information
- Usage data

#### Are we required to sign a Data Processing Agreement (DPA) with Tableau?

Because Tableau is a Salesforce company, all Tableau Online customers will be presented with the Salesforce Data Processing Addendum at the point of product registration or upon renewal. Note that our on-premise products are installed locally on your servers/computers, behind your firewall, and do not automatically transmit your Customer Data back to Tableau. Our Support staff members do not have a built-in remote connection to the software and cannot "tunnel" into your installation. Tableau is not the processor of the Customer Data of our customers licensing our on-premise software. Accordingly, a DPA is not required. Note that for any registration information that may be collected in order to fulfill our contractual obligations to you, Tableau is the controller and accepts related responsibilities under GDPR.

## Is there anything unique about Tableau Public?

Tableau Public users are subject to the <u>Terms of Service</u>, as well as the Tableau Public <u>Data Policy</u>. Tableau Public users should not post personal information of others unless they have consent to do so.

#### Does Tableau use any sub-processors?

For Tableau Online, the DPA references the <u>Salesforce Processor Binding Corporate Rules</u> and also includes the Standard Contractual Clauses. For data that Tableau collects and handles as a controller, please see the <u>Privacy Statement</u> for transfer information.
